We have bought out the entire restaurant Tommy Bahama's for our banquet on the evening of the 26th. I've also attached a few photos of the restaurant. In light of where our banquet will be, we have decided the dress code will be casual; slacks with Tommy Bahama's/Hawaiian shirts for the guys, sun dresses, flowered skirts, or slacks and tropical blouses for the women.

At least half the group is coming in a day or two early, staying a day or two late or both to spend some more time with old friends, go to the beach or play golf. Since we are giving Beach Vacations more nightly revenue than just the two nights we contracted for, I have persuaded them to give us the hospitality suite for four nights, Monday - Thursday for free! However, we are only pricing in two nights of hospitality suite costs in

everyone's bill, so those people staying longer may have to chip in a little more to keep it restocked. Since our local invited guests are not staying at the Market Common, hospitality suite and administrative costs will not be included in their bills. They are, however, more than welcome to come out and have a drink with us! I would now like to give you a grand overview of what we have planned for our two day event and just before the reunion I will send you a final schedule of events that you can print out and bring with you.

Tuesday, 25 September:

Hospitality suite open 1200 - 1000 People arriving all day.

Dinner is basically on your own, but we have some ideas and options for those that wish to join.

There are four restaurants at Market Common. Since we are eating at Tommy Bahama's on Wednesday night, why don't you try one of the other three on Tuesday night. I have worked out discounts for anyone wearing a Green Demon nametag at P.F. Chang's, Gordon Biersch and La Travinia. We will have reservations for thirty people at each of the restaurants and a signup sheet for each in the hospitality suite.

One LPA member will be a group leader for each of the restaurants to get the group seated together. We will try to have a two hour window for our reservation so you can come and go as you want with the big crowd or as a small group. Everyone is responsible for their own checks.

If you just want to chill out, have a pizza delivered to your room or the hospitality suite.

Wednesday, 26 September:

0800 Guys only breakfast at the Veterans Cafe & Grill & Mini Military Museum. It's about two blocks from the condos in the

old 355TFS building. We will have the place to ourselves from 0800-1000. He will serve a manly buffet of scrambled eggs, bacon, sausage, grits, potatoes, coffee and juice for \$7.99 a person with tax included. I figure \$10 (not included in your final bill) a head will cover it with tip and the reunion fund can throw in any extra we need.
